Toby Jurovics has been a curator of photography at the Smithsonian American Art Museum since March 2006. His research interests encompass the history of photography from the Civil War era to contemporary artists working today, with a particular emphasis on landscape photography and the American West. He is working currently on a Timothy O'Sullivan exhibition, scheduled for 2010.

Before joining the museum's staff, Jurovics was a curator of photography at the Princeton University Art Museum. While there, he organized numerous exhibitions, including "Robert Adams: From the Missouri West" (2004), "Photographs by Barbara Bosworth" (2000) and "Emmet Gowin: Aerial Photographs" (1998).

Jurovics earned a bachelor's degree in art history and English from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill (1988), and a master's degree in art history from the University of Delaware (1992). He wrote his thesis on "The New York Photographs of Karl Struss."

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
